CERVICAL & BREAST CANCER ERADICATION CAMPAIGN

- Screening of 6% women of reproductive age group suffering from pelvic inflammatory disease and from high risk category for cervical cancer, was fixed by Health Dept., Government of Jharkhand due to continued efforts of WDW IMA Jharkhand.
- ❖ we achieved 50% of target of screening of 2,70,000 women of reproductive age group that is 1,27,000
- MGM Medical College, Jamshedpur ad Sadar Hospital, Ramgarh got equipped with Cervical ad Breast Cancer screening equipment's and Cervical pre cancer treatment equipments.

In this video conferencing State Health Minister Shri Banna Gupta announced that the government has sanctioned Rs. 1.32 Crore in the upcoming budget for equipping the State-run district hospitals with Cervical Pre Cancer detection and treatment as well as Breast cancer detection machines.

VISION FOR JHARKHAND CAMPAIGN

- 1. In the month of **January 2022** two Free Eye Checkup & Cataract Surgery Camp organized in Ranchi district. The first camp was organized in collaboration with Kanke General Hospital, Ranchi on 5th January 2022 and the another one with Bazaar Samiti Chatakpur, Pandra in Patel Niwash, Chatakpur, Ranchi on 27th January 2022. More than 500 peoples were checked and 50 plus operated.
- 2. In the month of **February 2022** four <u>Cataract Screening and Surgery</u> <u>Camp</u> were organised. Details are as follows:
 - (i) Cataract Screening and Surgery Camp with JSWF at Hatia, Ranchi on 3rd February 2022.
 - (ii) Camp with Prayas Society, Ranchi at Namkum, Ranchi on 13th February 2022.
 - (iii) Camp with Junior Chamber International (JCI) at Jagarnathpur, Ranchi on 21st February 2022.
 - (iv) Camp with Prayas Society at Angara, Ranchi on 27th February 2022.
- 3. In the month of **March 2022** three Eye camps were organized. Details are as follows:

- (i) Cataract Screening and Surgery Camp at Goradih, Nagedih and Lota Block, Silli, Ranchi on 3rd, 6th and 9th March 2022.
- (ii) Cataract Screening and Surgery Camp at Kotam, Bisariya Panchayat, Ranchi on 13 March 2022.
- (iii) Cataract Screening and Surgery Camp at Bansaruli, Silli, Ranchi on 20th March 2022.
- 4. In April-2022 two **Free Eye Checkup & Cataract Surgery Camp** in Ranchi district. The first camp was conducted at Panchayat Bhawan, Diwaru and the second one at Panchayat Bhawan, Banta Hazam, Ranchi on 4th and 11th April 2022 respectively. Through these camps 113 patients were examined and 43 operated.
- 5. In May-2022 four **Free Eye Checkup Camp** were organized. Details are as follows:
 - (i) First Camp at Government Middle School, Lalganj Suganu, Kanke, Ranchi on 01 May 2022.
 - (ii) Second Free Eye Checkup Camp with Railway at Hatia, Ranchi on 07 May 2022.
 - (iii) Third with AMITY University Jharkhand at Samudaik Bhawan, Hindustan Chowk Manitola, Doranda, Ranchi on 10-05-2022 and
 - (iv) Fourth Free Eye Checkup Camp with Usha Martin, Namkum, Ranchi on 12-05-2022.
- 6. Two days **Free Eye Checkup and Cataract Surgery Camp** were organized at Pandra, Ranchi on 17th and 18th September 2022. 600 Patients were screened and 400 spectacles distributed.
- 7. One **Free Eye Checkup Camp** was organized in collaboration with Vikas Vidyalaya, Ranchi on 9th December 2022. 100+ students were screened.
